

Maintenance Guide

Watering

Temperature Range	32 F - 59 F	60 F - 84 F	85 F and above
When To Start Watering	Day of Installation	Within 20 minutes of installing	Water each piece as it is put down
How Often To Water	Every other day for two weeks	Once a day for two weeks	Twice a day for two weeks
How Much To Water	Depth of 1/2"	Depth of 1/2"	Depth of 1/2"

Fertilizing

1. Early Spring, once soil temps reach 55 F, apply a good and balanced fertilizer such as a 10-10-10 or a 15-15-15 to wake the grass up following Winter
2. On Memorial Day, apply a 4:1:2 ratio based fertilizer, such as 18-5-9
3. On July 4th, apply the same fertilizer used in the previous application
4. On Labor Day, apply a 2:1:4 ratio based fertilizer, such as 8-4-24
5. Between Halloween & Thanksgiving, spread a balanced winterizing fertilizer such as 10-10-10 or 15-15-15. Balance is Key!!

*** Make sure to follow recommended rates on fertilizer bags & be sure to not overlap.

Mowing

For best results, mow regularly, removing no more than 1/3 of the grass height in a single mowing. Doing so will eliminate the need for clipping collection, allowing them to return to the lawn where they can decompose and return essential nutrients back to the soil.

Set your mower height about three inches and never cut shorter than two inches. Allowing the lawn to grow within this range will ensure a deeply rooted turf more resistant to weeds and drought.
